MINUTES OF THE 51st MEETING OF GENERAL COUNCIL

The 51st meeting of the General Council of NCERT was held on 3rd December, 2013 at 3.30 p.m. in the Conference Room No. 1, India International Centre, 40, Max Mueller Marg, New Delhi – 110003. The list of participants who attended the meeting is attached as Annexure '1'. Dr. M.M. Pallam Raju, Hon'ble Minister for Human Resource Development, Government of India and President of the NCERT, chaired the meeting.

The Director, NCERT welcomed the members of the Committee, following which, with the permission of the Chair, the agenda items were taken up by the Secretary, NCERT for deliberations.

However, at the outset, the Minister of Education, Bihar, a member of the General Council, raised his concern that the agenda for the meeting had not been received by him in time. Secretary, MHRD advised NCERT to ensure that members get the agenda at least a week before the meeting in future.

Item No.1: Confirmation of the minutes of the 50th meeting of the General Council held on 3rd December, 2012

As no comments were received from any member of the General Council on the minutes of the 50th meeting, held on 3rd December, 2012, the minutes were confirmed.

Item No.2: Action Taken Report on the minutes of the meeting of the General Council held on 3rd December 2012

The Secretary, NCERT reported the actions taken on the minutes of the last meeting, which were noted by the members.



Item No.3: To consider and approve the Annual Report of NCERT for the year 2012-13

The Director, NCERT, presented the highlights of the year under report. Following this, the Council approved the Annual Report of the NCERT for the year 2012-13.

Item No.4: To consider and approve the Audited Annual Accounts of NCERT for the year 2012-13

The members approved the Audited Annual Accounts of NCERT for the year 2012-13.

Any other Item:

The members of the General Council raised the following issues for the consideration of the General Council:

- 1. (i) Education Minister of Bihar, Shri P.K. Shahi informed the members that NCERT had requested the State Government of Bihar for land to be provided to set up a Regional Institute of Education. The State has identified an appropriate site, which has been visited by the JD, NCERT, but the State had not heard from NCERT after that. The status of the proposal to setup an RIE in Andhra Pradesh was also enquired and the Director, NCERT was asked to take urgent further action. In this context, the Secretary, MHRD wanted the status of the EFC Memos for the new RIEs. The Secretary, NCERT informed him that the revised EFC Memo was being sent to the MHRD.
 - (ii) Sh. Shahi and Ms. Rukmini Banerjee of Pratham observed that the NCERT textbooks in Languages and Maths should be age appropriate. They emphasized that the NCERT may undertake research on this issue so as to bridge the gap. The General Council observed that the NCERT may constitute a committee of experts to looking into these aspects and take further action in a time bound manner to address the issue.



- 2. Shri Bosiram Siram, Education Minister of Arunachal Pradesh, raised the following issues:
 - (a) Non-provisioning of mechanism for protection of endangered languages of Arunachal Pradesh.
 - (b) non-availability of state specific quality study material for teacher education;
 - (c) absence of Horticulture/Agriculture based vocational curricula for students of upper primary and secondary level;
 - (d) non-mention of Tawang Monastery in the NCERT curriculum inspite of it being of world importance;
 - (e) non-availability of academic support for developing the SCERT;
 - (f) non-availability of NCERT textbooks at the Regional Productioncum- Distribution Centre (RPDC), Guwahati;
 - (g) non-existence of teachers with the ability to undertake Guidance and Counseling of children;
 - (h) support for digitising their libraries;
 - (i) support for improving Science, Mathematics and Language teaching in Arunachal Pradesh, and the NER in general.

The Hon'ble Minister was informed by the Director, NCERT that the NCERT had immediately started work last year in Arunachal Pradesh on some of these issues, and the others would be looked into soon.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
